Since 1903, the Alte Simpl has been an integral part of Schwabing. Founded by landlady Kathi Kobus, frequented by artists such as Frank Wedekind and Ringelnatz, filled with literature, debates, and piano music. Today, two friends continue running this traditional inn in women's hands—modern, warm, and a bit wild. With young Bavarian-international cuisine, art on the walls, games, piano, culture, and the invitation to meet, enjoy, and perhaps be a little inspired.

Our goal at the Alte Simpl is to offer you a menu that is as regional and animal-welfare-conscious as possible, at fair prices. We can't achieve this everywhere just yet, but we're working on it and always want to keep improving. We look forward to your feedback!

Meat & Sausages

We source mainly from the Ott butcher shop in Garching, which works with farmers from the region.

Game

Comes from Eva's own hunting—when she is successful.

Beef

We regularly get the best beef from mountain farmer Seppi, directly from the Sockhof in Oberaudorf—clearly marked on the menu.

Pork

Our pork comes from pigs kept on straw, with 40% more space than legally required.

Bread

Our organic house bread comes from the Brotraum bakery in Schwabing.

Provided by our friends at Greenforce—a Munich-based company.
